

Call for Applications: Faculty Success Program

The Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion is offering sponsorship for up to one faculty member from each school at UAB to attend the NCFDD Summer 2024 Faculty Success Program May 20 – July 28, 2024.

The Faculty Success Program is a 12-week program for faculty of all ranks who are looking for the perfect combination of empirically-tested methods to improve research productivity through intense accountability, coaching, and peer support and to propel their work-life balance and personal growth to a whole new level. Tuition for the Faculty Success Program is \$5,150. The Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion will provide 50% of tuition for up to one faculty member from each school or college in 2024. The other 50% of the tuition will be matched by the dean of the faculty member's school/college.

All full-time tenure and non-tenure track assistant and associate professors are eligible to participate. Women and applicants from historically underrepresented populations are especially encouraged to apply.

Participants will be chosen through a competitive internal selection process and decisions will be announced by March 29, 2024.
