Application For The John Dillon Scholarship For Printmaking

Description: The Department of Art and Art History awards the Dillon Scholarship to a student who is a Studio Art major with an emphasis in Printmaking. The Scholarship was created through the generous donations of friends, colleagues, students and former students of Professor John Dillon who taught Printmaking within the Department from 1972 to 1997.

Application deadline: 4:30 pm on the third Wednesday of April.

Requirements:

1. Completed form on reverse side of this announcement.
2. Applicant's unofficial UAB transcript.
3. Representative portfolio of your work as an artist, working with a primary emphasis in printmaking and drawing. The portfolio should include no more than 10 slides or original works.

Rules governing award and tenure of scholarships:

1. Applicant must be enrolled in at least ARS 240 or 241, Beginning printmaking.
2. Preference will be given to Art Studio majors with a focus in printmaking.
3. An overall 2.75 GPA, with a GPA of 3.00 in art courses, is the minimum requirement to be considered for this scholarship.
4. The faculty of the Department of Art and Art History will choose the John Dillon Scholarship Award from among the applicants. If there is no qualified applicant, no award will be granted.
5. The scholarship will be paid in the subsequent semester of the award being announced.
6. Preference will be given to full time students registered for at least 12 semester hours. If the award is used during the summer term, the applicant need only be registered for 9 semester hours.
7. If a student withdraws in a term for which they receive the stipend, or fails to maintain a 'C' average, any balance of the scholarship will not be paid.
8. Late applications will not be considered.
