Application for the Kluge/Langley Scholarship

The Department of Art and Art History awards the Kluge/Langley Scholarship is open to art majors in any concentration. The Scholarship is awarded from the endowment created by the former UAB Sculpture Professor Janice Kluge, husband Cam Langley and their family and friends

Deadlin: 4:30 pm on the fourth Wednesday in
January

Requirements:

1. The completed application form.
2. The applicant's unofficial UAB transcript.
3. A representative portfolio of your work. That portfolio should include digital images of no fewer than 4 works and no more than 10.

Rules governing the award and tenure of the scholarship:

1. An applicant must have completed at least 12 hours at UAB.
2. An applicant must be a major in art studio.
3. An applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.00 with a GPA of 3.00 in art courses to be considered for this scholarship.
4. The faculty of the Department of Art and Art History will choose the Kluge/Langley scholar from among applicants. If there is no applicant who is qualified in the judgment of the faculty, no scholarship will be awarded.
5. The scholarship will be paid in two semesters or one semester and a summer term.
6. The Kluge/Langley Scholar must be a full-time student registered for at least 12 semester hours for which the scholarship is paid. A student using the award in the summer term need only be registered for nine semester hours. Exceptions to this rule can, however, be made.
7. If the Scholar withdraws in a term for which the Scholar receives a stipend, or fails to maintain a cumulative 'C' average for that term, any balance of the scholarship will not be paid.
8. Late applications will not be considered.
