Application for the Weaver/Harvey Scholarship

The Department of Art and Art History awards the Weaver/Harvey Scholarship to a student who is a studio art major with an emphasis on graphic design. That student should be a junior at the beginning of the fall term. The Scholarship is awarded from the endowment created by the former UAB Graphic Design professor Marie Weaver, Steve Harvey and their family and friends

Deadline: 4:30 pm on the fourth Wednesday in January

Requirements:

1. The completed form on the reverse of this announcement.
2. The applicant's unofficial UAB transcript.
3. A representative CD portfolio of your work as an artist. The CD should include no fewer than 5 works and no more than 10. Images should be in JPG format at 2400 pixels in their largest dimension. Please do not send original work. All portfolios should include a list of works including title, size, medium, and date.

Rules governing the award and tenure of the scholarship:

1. An applicant must be, by the beginning of the upcoming Fall semester, a junior who has completed at least 60 semester hours of undergraduate work. At least 12 of those hours must have been at UAB.
2. An applicant must be a major in art studio with an emphasis on Graphic Design.
3. An applicant must have completed or be currently enrolled in ARS 350.
4. An applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.75 with a GPA of 3.00 in art courses to be considered for this scholarship.
5. The faculty of the Department of Art and Art History will choose the Weaver/Harvey scholar from among applicants. If there is no applicant who is qualified in the judgment of the faculty, no scholarship will be awarded.
6. The scholarship will be paid in two semesters or two semesters and a summer term.
7. The Weaver/Harvey Scholar must be a full-time student registered for at least 12 semester hours for which the scholarship is paid. A student using the award in the summer term need only be registered for nine semester hours. Exceptions to this rule can, however, be made.
8. If the Scholar withdraws in a term for which the Scholar receives a stipend, or fails to maintain a cumulative 'C' average for that term, any balance of the scholarship will not be paid.
9. Late applications will not be considered.
