

Employee Emergency Assistance Program (EEAP) has existed since the Benevolent Fund's inception in 1984. The program has provided \$4.6 million to 4,700+ employees. In FY22 employees could receive a maximum of \$1,250 during a 12-month period. In FY23, the award amount was increased to \$1,500. With increased contributions, the Council hopes to be able to increase the financial assistance award again in the near future. At UAB, we support one another, and when UAB employees encounter their most difficult days, the EEAP is available to help them navigate their path forward.
