Modern Dance I - Learn the basics of modern dance techniques.

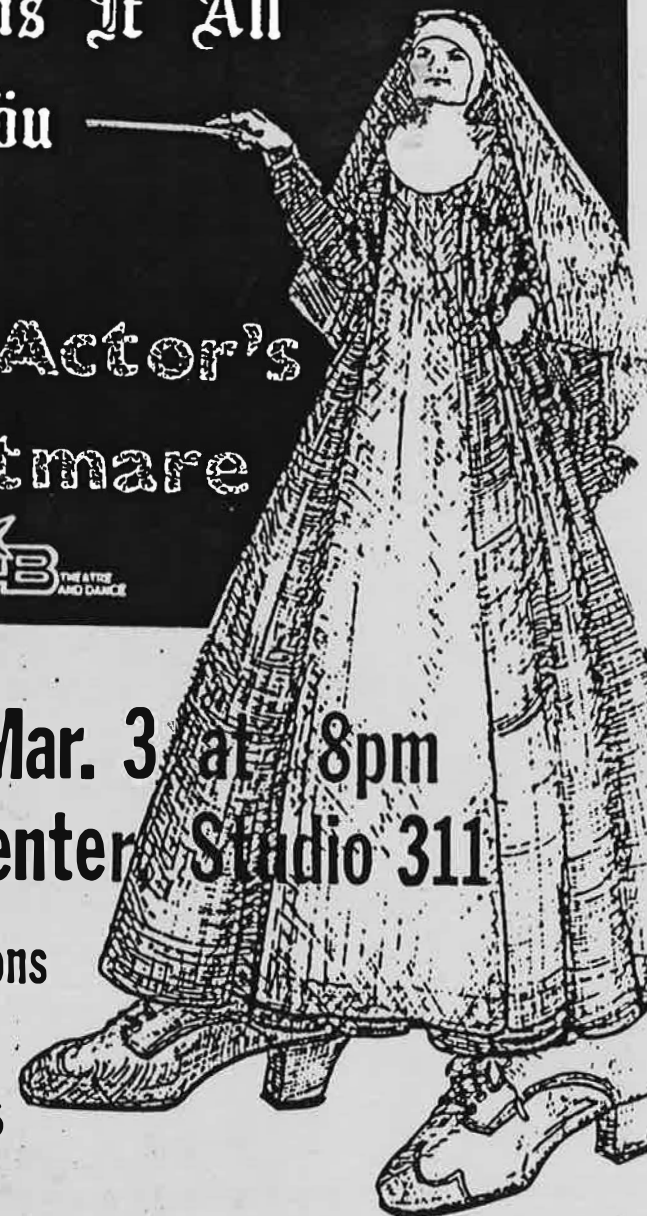
Jazz Dance I - Learn the styles exemplified by contemporary musical theatre and television productions.
