Camp Guidelines

- Camp hours are 8:30 a.m.— 4:00 p.m. All Campers must be signed-in and -out daily by parent/guardian. Please provide a written note if someone other than a parent or guardian will pick-up your child.
- Camp Staff will be setup in the Lobby of the CH19 Building (933-19th Street South) from 7:30 a.m.— 5:30 p.m. daily during Camp. Late pick-up will result in a \$5.00 charge per 15 minutes after 5:30 p.m.
- Camp Attire: **No** short shorts, bandanas, head scarfs, over-sized accessories/clothes, halter tops, or hats inside the building, and no sagging pants. Campers are on a college-campus and should be appropriately dressed. Acceptable Attire: knee-length shorts, Capri pants, blouses, t-shirts, moderate-sized jewelry and appropriately-sized clothing. Parents will be contacted if inappropriately dressed.
- Campers are required to bring a lunch daily except for Friday Pizza Day.
- If medication is prescribed or to be taken, please inform Camp Counselor in writing.
