In addition to meeting the requirements for admission to the Graduate School, a candidate must meet requirements for unconditional admission to the Early Childhood Special Education (P-3) Program. To be eligible for unconditional admission to this Class A certification program, a candidate must hold a valid Alabama bachelor's level Professional Educator Certificate in Early Childhood Special Education (P-3) or a valid Alabama bachelor's level Professional Educator Certificate in any teaching field.

Please Note: If an individual is unconditionally admitted to this Class A program based on a valid bachelor's level professional educator certification from another state, this individual must hold valid Alabama Class B Professional Educator Certificate before completing this Class A program and subsequently applying for Alabama certification at the Class A level in Early Childhood Special Education (P-3).

- complete the Class A program with a minimum GPA of 3.25 on all courses on this checklist;
- achieve a passing score on a comprehensive assessment documenting mastery of the curriculum;
- possess an Alabama Class B Professional Certificate;
- individuals who do not hold a pre-requisite certificate in the same teaching field may have additional testing contact the Office of Student Services (call 205-934-7530);
- possess a passing score on the Special Education: Core Knowledge Praxis exam;
- meet all requirements for the Alabama Educators Certification Assessment Testing Program (AECAP) as a precondition for certification.
