Prior to unconditional admission to the Class A Instructional Leadership program, a prospective candidate must hold a valid, Class B Professional Educator Certificate (MAE) or a master's degree and valid Class A Professional Educator Certificate (PMC) in a teaching field or instructional support area. Additionally, the applicant must:

- Have a minimum of three full years of full-time, acceptable, professional educational experience in a P-12 setting, which must include one full year of full-time, P-12 classroom teaching experience;
- Successfully pass an admissions portfolio and interview; and
- Meet all requirements for admission to the UAB Graduate School.

Applicants who hold a valid Alabama Class A certificate in library media or school counseling that have been employed full-time in the same school district for seven full years, please contact the UAB School of Education Office of Student Services (call 205-934-7530) for Option 2 unconditional admission requirements.

Candidates may not take any courses with an EDL course prefix leading to certification prior to unconditional admission to the Instructional Leadership Program.

If course survey of special education was taken for prior level certification, another approved diversity course is required. EDL 612 meets the diversity course requirement.
