ASSISTANT PROFESSOR – SOCIAL WORK

The University of Alabama at Birmingham invites applications and nominations for one nine-month assistant professor position in the Social Work Department to begin August 15, 2017 to teach in the undergraduate and/or graduate program. Although all candidates will be considered, the Department is especially interested in individuals with research interests related to health or behavioral health. Candidates are expected to be able to contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community through their research, teaching, and service. Candidates for this position should have a strong research agenda and a clearly defined teaching philosophy. Candidates must hold a Ph.D. in Social Work or an allied profession at the time of the appointment. An M.S.W., two years practice experience, and license eligibility are all strongly preferred. Qualified applicants should submit a CV and letter of application detailing their research agenda and teaching philosophy.
