Course Description:

This course is the continuation of CHI 201. CHI 202 teaches the essentials of Chinese language and culture needed for proficient communication, and includes basic exercises in listening comprehension, speaking, writing, and reading. 3 hours.

Goals:

The goals of this course include a beginning mastery of reading, writing, oral comprehension, oral communication, and knowledge of Chinese culture. You will be tested on all of these aspects of language learning through written homework, classroom participation, and through periodic quizzes and exams. The course objectives are the following:

- To continue Chinese 201.
- To introduce more words and phrases of Mandarin.
- To teach the basic communication skills in Mandarin.
- To teach the essential grammar of Mandarin.
- To stress listening and speaking skills.
- To improve reading skills as well as writing skills (Chinese characters).
- To present an understanding of Chinese culture.

In order to ensure effective instruction and learning it is crucial that everyone prepares well **BEFORE** class: learn the **VOCABULARY** and go through the texts of the lesson **at least** once.

You will be graded on the following factors daily:

- being well-prepared for class
- making positive contributions to the class
- using Chinese in the classroom
- progress in the “skill of communication”
- volunteering to answer and ask questions
- alertness
- participation in exercises and activities
- good attitude

Character & Workbook and Vocabulary Quizzes: 10%

You are responsible for completing and submitting your Workbook and Character Workbook assignments when they are due. There will be a vocabulary quiz for each lesson (6 quizzes total)

Tests: 20%

There will be a test for each lesson (6 tests total).

Exams: 20%

There will be 2 exams: Exam 1 (Lessons 18–20) and Exam 2 (Lessons 18-23).

Cultural Participation: 5%

Each student is required to attend **at least two Chinese-related events** outside the class, on or off campus. Examples of such events include Chinese movies, Asian panel discussion, or the celebrations of Chinese Festivals and other events held by Chinese students and Scholars at UAB (CSSA). You can check for these events on the UAB Foreign Languages Department calendar, available online and on bulletin boards.

A participation form is provided on the last page of this syllabus. Two completed forms, one for each event attended, must be submitted **by the last day this class meets each semester**.

Each student is required to attend and participate in the Chinese Conversation Table/Chinese Club 10 times per semester. Each conversation will last approximately 10-15 minutes. Conversation hours will be announced. No appointments are available during the weeks that exams are administered.
