## **Rules / Guidelines for Fees and Refunds**

Unless otherwise indicated with the class information, all classes are free to UAB Health System Employees (University Hospital, UAB Medical West, UAB Highlands, TKC, and other UAB Clinics). Payment information should be included with the specific class information.

General fees / cost (may be more or less depending on the class/event):

## **CRITICAL CARE CONSORTIUM CLASSES**

## **TRAUMA NURSING COURSE**

This two day course is designed to provide the learner with cognitive knowledge and psychomotor skills related to trauma assessment and interventions. The trauma nursing process is reflected throughout the chapters and in the psychomotor skills stations. Lectures and psychomotor skill stations are presented by verified TNCC instructors and the lecture content is organized to provide the learner with substantive knowledge for use in the psychomotor skill stations. Participation in all psychomotor skill stations is required for completion of the course. Skill stations include: The trauma nursing process, airway and ventilation and spinal protection, helmet removal and splinting. Evaluation of learners includes a written multiple choice exam and the trauma nursing process station. These evaluations are designed to assess acquisition of cognitive knowledge, important skills and critical thinking. To successfully complete the course the learner must achieve 80% on the written exam and demonstrate all critical criteria and at least 70% of all steps in the trauma nursing process skills station.
