The PGY1 Residency in Pharmacy Practice: A one-year program accredited by the American Society of Health System Pharmacists (ASHP). The program provides a structured learning environment for the resident to gain exposure to all aspects of pharmacy practice, while allowing ample flexibility for the resident to pursue subjects of personal interest.

Orientation (6 Weeks)

Orientation provides a general overview of the departmental organization, support units and resident responsibilities.

- Ambulatory Care/Longitudinal Clinic (2 Weeks Introduction + 1/2 Day Per Week)
- Therapeutic Policy Management (4 Weeks)
- Pharmacy Administrative Rotation (2 Weeks)
