The PGY2 Residency in Critical Care: A one-year program designed to provide extensive experience in a variety of intensive care units. This experience will expand on skills developed during a postgraduate year one residency and build the skills and confidence necessary to provide advanced pharmacologic services in acute care situations.

Orientation (6 Weeks)

Orientation provides a general overview of the departmental organization, support units and resident responsibilities.

- Operating Room/ Anesthesia
- Trauma/ Burn Critical Care
