**Membership Involvement Subcommittee** – the purpose of this committee is to promote membership renewals, member involvement, coordinate new member orientation activities, and help the program committee with the induction ceremony. This subcommittee also promotes mentoring opportunities and the election of Nu chapter members to leadership within the Chapter, region, and the Society at large. We would love to identify representatives at each of the health care institutions in our area, who can work with the Membership Involvement committee to disseminate information about Chapter activities.

**Program Planning Subcommittee** – This committee is responsible for coordinating chapter programs (including two programmed meetings per year, as well as the annual Induction Ceremony). We need your ideas about exciting programs that will be of interest and benefit to our members!

**Publicity Subcommittee (Newsletter, Website)** – This subcommittee is responsible for publicizing all activities to members and other professionals, for developing and maintaining the Chapter web page, and for preparing and disseminating newsletters 3-4 times per year. We need creative minds for this subcommittee!

**Nominating Subcommittee (Help us identify potential chapter leaders!)** - This is a very important committee, as the members prepare the annual ballot for chapter leadership positions. We need representatives from a broad range of health care institutions to make sure that our leaders include members from a variety of backgrounds and work settings.

**Awards Subcommittee** – The Awards Subcommittee is responsible for publicizing opportunities for scholarships, scholar support, and research grants, and for reviewing applications for these awards.

**Heritage Subcommittee** – This committee is responsible for collecting, organizing, preserving and maintaining print and audiovisual materials pertaining to the Chapter, and also maintaining all permanent legal documents and an inventory of the chapter items needed for the induction ceremony. If you enjoy taking photographs and organizing information, this is the subcommittee for you!

**Bylaws Subcommittee** – This subcommittee oversees the creation and update of bylaws to ensure that chapter bylaws are in compliance with international bylaws. This subcommittee is chaired by the President-Elect of the chapter.
