

Development Grant

Purpose: To provide limited financial support to nurse leaders who want to advance selected short-term projects, activities, events, or programs that exemplify nursing leadership.

Eligibility: Active (dues paying) Nu Chapter member in good standing at the time of the application due date.*

*Note: A member in good standing is a dues paying member, verified with National STT office by a member of Nu Chapter's Board of Directors.

Expenditures:

1. Money may be used for one-time purchases or expenses for clinical or educational projects when other avenues of funding are not available.
2. Money cannot be used for salary, personnel, travel or research.
3. A maximum of \$500 per year per project/event is available to any active Nu Chapter member.
4. Depending on numbers and quality of applicants, the award may be split between candidates.
5. Individuals who receive funds may reapply in subsequent years, but will not be given first priority for additional funding.
6. The total amount of money available annually depends upon the amount of money approved by the chapter's Board of Directors.

Outcomes: The plan for using the grant money must be consistent with the objectives of Sigma Theta Tau International and with the advancement of nursing. Projects with measurable outcomes will be given a high priority for funding.

The objectives of the Society are to:

1. Recognize superior academic achievement.
2. Recognize the development of leadership qualities.
3. Foster high professional standards.
4. Encourage creative work.
5. Strengthen commitment to the ideals and purposes of the profession.

Eligible Projects:

- Clinical - Projects undertaken to meet the clinical needs of a particular group of clients/patients.

- **Educational - Projects undertaken to meet the educational needs of a particular group.**

Examples: the purchase of supplies, testing, or educational materials for individuals or groups when other avenues of funding are not available.

Procedure: Applications for Development Grants will be accepted once a year . The deadline for submission of applications will be the first working day in March or March 1 (There will be no exceptions).

Submission materials include:

- 1. Completed application and accountability form .**
- 2. An itemized budget with justification.**
- 3. If appropriate, endorsement from an administrative superior.**

Contact the Chairperson of the Awards Committee with additional questions. Proposal will be reviewed by the Awards Committee of Nu Chapter. Awards will be considered that demonstrate an ability to enhance nursing leadership. Announcements will occur after the Board of Directors have approved the award. The Development Award will be presented at the end of each Spring Semester at the Induction Ceremony .

A written report of allocated funds will be due within six months after receiving the grant money. This report may be published in a Nu Chapter publication. Acknowledgement of the The Nu Chapter as the source of funding must be noted in any publication about the project.
