### APPLICATION CHECKLIST

#### Here's what you need to do to apply to UAB:

- Complete this application.
- Attach the \$35 application fee. (See details below.)
- Submit all required documents. (See details below.)
- Send everything to UAB Undergraduate Admission by the appropriate priority deadline. (See next page for dates and mailing address.)

### ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION

Make the application process quick and easy by applying online at [www.uab.edu/apply](http://www.uab.edu/apply). You'll also pay a smaller application fee—just \$30. If you choose to apply online, you must still follow the instructions about academic credentials, proof of immunization, and deadlines listed in this brochure.

## 1. Complete the Application

- All students applying to UAB—both degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking applicants—must complete an application.
- To answer question 10, choose an undergraduate major from the box on the next page. If you are unsure about a particular major, write "Undeclared."

## 2. Attach the Application Fee

- You must submit a \$35 nonrefundable application fee with your completed application.
- If you submit your application to UAB by mail, you can pay by check or money order. If you submit your application in person, you can also pay your fee in cash or by credit card. Make checks payable to UAB.

## 3. Submit Your Academic Credentials

### DEGREE-SEEKING APPLICANTS

#### Beginning Freshmen

**Who:** Applicants who have never enrolled in an accredited college or university  
**Applicants may apply the summer prior to the senior year of high school.**

#### What to Do:

- Ask your high school to mail your official transcript directly to UAB Undergraduate Admission. (You can apply after your junior year of high school. If accepted, you must send a final official transcript upon graduation.)
- Ask the appropriate testing agency to send your official ACT or SAT score report directly to UAB Undergraduate Admission.
- If you have earned a General Equivalency Diploma (GED), an official test score must be sent to UAB directly from the testing agency/institute. **Applicants submitting a GED score must be at least 19 years old.**

#### Transfer and Postbaccalaureate

**Who:** Applicants who have previously enrolled in an accredited college or university  
**What to Do:**

- Ask each college you have attended to mail official transcripts directly to UAB Undergraduate Admission. (If you are currently attending another college or university, UAB may make an admission decision with one term pending. UAB will require a final transcript at the conclusion of your coursework.)

- Applicants with less than 24 semester hours/36 quarter hours of transferable college credit must also satisfy requirements for beginning freshmen and submit the credentials listed in that section.

#### Former UAB Students

**Who:** Applicants who have not enrolled at UAB in more than one year, applicants who have attended another regionally accredited institution since attending UAB, and/or students who have graduated from UAB

#### What to Do:

- Ask each institution you have attended (except UAB) to send your official transcript directly to UAB Undergraduate Admission.

#### International Applicants

**Who:** Anyone who is not a citizen or permanent resident of the United States

#### What to Do:

- Provide proof of academic, linguistic, and financial qualifications. For complete details, contact UAB Undergraduate Admission or visit [www.uab.edu/international](http://www.uab.edu/international).

### NON-DEGREE-SEEKING APPLICANTS

#### Temporary

**Who:** Applicants seeking personal enrichment or career enhancement opportunities

#### What to Do:

- You must be **at least 25 years old** to apply as a temporary student.
- Submit an official letter of good standing if you have attended any college within the last year.

**Note:** Temporary students are admitted to UAB's Division of General Studies and can enroll for a total of 12 semester hours with a maximum of 4 semester hours each term. Enrollment beyond 12 hours requires either the approval of a General Studies advisor and proof of high school graduation OR a change in status to a degree-seeking student.

#### Transient

**Who:** Applicants who want to transfer credit earned at UAB back to their home institutions (where they are enrolled)

#### What to Do:

- Submit an official letter of good standing from your home institution.

**Note:** Transient student enrollment typically lasts for one term, with a maximum of two consecutive terms. If your transient enrollment is not in consecutive terms, you must submit a letter of good standing for each term you enroll at UAB; if you have not enrolled at UAB for three or more consecutive terms, you must reapply.

#### Postbaccalaureate

**Who:** Applicants with a baccalaureate degree who wish to meet prerequisites for advanced programs or satisfy requirements for professional certification

#### What to Do:

- Ask the college from which you obtained your degree to mail an official transcript to UAB Undergraduate Admission.

## 4. Submit Proof of Immunization

To enroll at UAB, all first-time entering students born on or after January 1, 1957, must submit proof of immunization against rubeola (red measles). Send in a UAB *Certificate of Immunization* form, the *State of Alabama Form IMM-90*, or other documentation from your health care provider showing the date of the second dose of MMR immunization.

## 5. Meet the Deadline

- UAB has two priority deadline dates each semester.

### DEADLINE #1 APPLIES TO YOU IF YOU ARE APPLYING AS:

- a beginning freshman
- a transfer student with less than 24 semester/36 quarter transferable hours
- an international student

### DEADLINE #2 APPLIES TO YOU IF YOU ARE APPLYING AS:

- a transfer student with 24 semester/36 quarter transferable hours or more
- a transient student;
- a former UAB student;
- a postbaccalaureate student; or
- a temporary student.

- UAB Undergraduate Admission must receive all required admission materials (application, fee, and all required academic documents) by 5:00 p.m on your appropriate deadline date. If the deadline falls on a weekend or university holiday, your application will be considered the following business day.

## Residency for Tuition Purposes

Alabama, like other states, restricts resident tuition to persons who have been residing in Alabama for purposes other than to obtain an education, and who are able to demonstrate contacts with the State of Alabama that indicate an intent to remain in this state. Resident tuition status is determined by the University, with regard to Alabama law, and the policies of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama System and UAB.

- Guidelines for determining residency for tuition purposes are independent of other regulations used by state authorities to determine residency in the state of Alabama. For example, having an Alabama driver's license, an Alabama car tag, and/or voter registration would not necessarily demonstrate residency for tuition purposes.
- Attending UAB does not establish residence for tuition purposes. Residence in Alabama is residing at a single location with the intent of remaining there indefinitely, as opposed to living in Alabama solely to obtain an education.
- In determining resident or nonresident classification, the primary issue is one of intent. If a person is in Alabama primarily for the purpose of obtaining an education, that person will generally be considered a nonresident student.
- Documents supporting a reclassification application should be, but are not required to be, dated, issued, or filed twelve (12) months before the first day of classes of the semester for which reclassification is sought.
- If you are 19 years of age or older, you must establish residency based on your own circumstances and not that of your parent(s) or guardian.
