## **Preparing for the Flexible Sigmoidoscopy**

Flexible Sigmoidoscopy is an office procedure recommended by your physician in order to examine a lower portion of the colon (large intestine) with a flexible instrument. During the examination, air will be put into the colon through the instrument so that the doctor can better see the lining of the bowel. This may cause a feeling of fullness or some mild cramping. The test takes approximately 15-30 minutes and requires the following preparation:

## **Day before procedure:**

• You will need to purchase two (2) Fleet enemas from your local pharmacy/drugstore. Fleet enemas are over the counter and do not require a prescription.

## **Day of procedure:**

- Clear liquid breakfast. Examples: non-pulp juice, black coffee, teal broth, apple juice, clear gelatin, popsicles (with no fruit), and Gatorade.
- Two hours before you leave your home you need to administer the first Fleet enema and retain for 10 minutes.
- One hour before you leave home, administer the second Fleet enema and retain for 10 minutes.
- Arrive 30 minutes before your procedure.

IMPORTANT: Please notify your doctor and our office if you have had a heart valve replacement or have a history of diabetes mellitus. DO NOT CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
