




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

#### GORGAS ADVANCED COURSE

- Established in 1999 in collaboration with UAB
- Two-week course in English in August
- Twenty participants per year
- Focus on bedside teaching
- Participants from all over the world with experience in tropical medicine
- Interactive discusión with local staff on difficult cases











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#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- To train health care providers in Tropical Medicine in a multicultural educational program with international experts on the field.
- To expose participants to a broad spectrum of tropical diseases and provide clinical knowledge and skills to recognize, diagnose, treat, and prevent them with a *special emphasis on practicing in resource-limited settings*.
- To create a *network of experts* aiming to improve healthcare services for underserved populations around the globe.

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#### • Diploma in Tropical Medicine & Hygiene

- ✓ The Diploma in Tropical Medicine & Hygiene will be issued by the Gorgas Memorial Institute of Tropical and Preventive Medicine only to those completing the course and who successfully pass the comprehensive Diploma Examination given at the end of the course. This will satisfy the didactic requirement for the ASTMH examination process. Eligibility for the Diploma requires:
  - Attendance during all Clinical Rounds sessions on the field trips to Cusco & Iquitos
  - Attendance to a minimum of 95% of all course activities
  - Passing grade in the final course exam
  - Sitting for the final exam in order to qualify for the Diploma is an entirely optional process.





#### • Certificate in Clinical Tropical Medicine

✓ A Certificate in Clinical Tropical Medicine will be issued jointly by Universidad Peruana Cayetano Heredia and the Gorgas Memorial Institute of Tropical and Preventive Medicine to everyone attending the complete course.





#### • CME Credit

- ✓ 125 hours of Category 1 credits are available. The cost of this is included in the Gorgas tuition.
- ✓ The University of Alabama School of Medicine is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education for physicians.
- ✓ The University of Alabama School of Medicine designates this educational activity for a maximum of 125 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits<sup>TM</sup>. Physicians should claim only the credit that corresponds to their participation in the activity.
