



## **Sumeet Munjal wins the KIDNEYcon Jeopardy Competition!!!**

Little Rock, Arkansas – The 2nd Annual KIDNEYcon CE conference was held on April 7-8, 2017. Friday night's festivities featured a live jeopardy competition for fellows and residents, which included five teams of four contestants who answered questions on a wide range of renal topics. The game was heated, but Sumeet Munjal's team prevailed above the rest. The winning team was comprised of Drs.: 1) Sumeet Munjal, fellow at UAB; 2) Salma Elbehary, fellow at Baylor University in Dallas; 3) Omar Rabadi, fellow at UAMS; and 4) Gebran Khneizer, resident at St. Louis University. Winners were awarded bragging rights, a 1<sup>st</sup> place Jeopardy Champion car magnet and a 1<sup>st</sup> place Jeopardy Champion beverage coaster! In addition, the winning player's institution gets the right to display the 1<sup>st</sup> place Jeopardy badge on their website.

The two-day conference, sponsored by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) Division of Nephrology, featured four workshops designed to provide a unique, hands-on experience for physicians and trainees to improve their understanding of how and why interventions are done, increase their comfort with the techniques, and help them understand their own level of interest in the tools. The workshops are focused on providing a realistic experience and utilized overview talks, live human models, simulation equipment, and cadavers. Saturday's conference provided strategies to deal with problems such as the management of patients with acute kidney injury and new modes of diagnosis in glomerular disease. Twenty-eight nephrologists, pathologists, and interventional nephrologists from across the nation presented on a wide range of renal topics throughout the conference.
