He also has an M.A. degree in Experimental Psychology from Wake Forest University and a B.A. in Psychology from the College of William & Mary. He completed an internship in clinical psychology at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center.

Dr. Novack is Board Certified in the area of Clinical Neuropsychology. Most of his clinical practice involves the assessment and treatment of adults with acquired brain disorders, particularly traumatic brain injury. He has published extensively on the topic of traumatic brain injury in professional journals and serves as the Project Director for the UAB Traumatic Brain Injury Model System, which is funded by the National Institute on Disability, Independent Living, and Rehabilitation Research.
