



Guidelines for Scholarships for Disadvantaged Students (AMNP Program/Pre-Licensure)

Please read carefully and complete the attached application in full. Failure to do so may result in your application not being considered.

Federal guidelines governing the receipt of funds stipulate that:

A trainee may be enrolled Full Time in the AMNP course of study with a nursing major in primary care to be eligible for this award.

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Good academic standing with the School of Nursing
- No defaults on Federal loans
- Enrolled in AMNP Program as Pre-Licensure status
- Must be in a **primary care specialty track**
- A Completed FAFSA
- Intent to practice in a rural and/or in a health professional shortage area upon graduation
- Priority is given to individuals from a a) disadvantaged background, or b) underrepresented minorities.

The established procedure of the School of Nursing for governing the receipt of funds stipulates that:

The amount of the award is based on Fulltime (9 credit hours or more) or Part-time (at least 6 credit hours) status. Your account balance will be verified before funds are disbursed and will be adjusted accordingly if your status has changed or abuse of Federal funds has been noticed. You must remit a copy of your Account Summary each term, no later than 5 days after registering for classes.

Funding is limited to one year while completing the AMNP Program.

Only the following items are covered by the Traineeship:

1. Tuition
2. Reasonable Living Expenses (based on available funds)
3. Student Service Fee
4. Student Health Fee
5. Building Fee
6. Learning Resource Center Fee

You are responsible for all other expenses not paid by the Traineeship, e.g. parking, hospital insurance, add/drop fees and diploma fees. The attached application must be complete in order to be considered for the Traineeship stipend.
