Angela Jukkala Serving the Needs of Rural Hospitals



Throughout her career Dr. Angela Jukkala has been interested in serving the needs of medically underserved populations. Early on, Jukkala worked as a nurse in small rural hospitals and witnessed, first-hand, the difficulties associated with providing care to isolated populations. As a result of these experiences, Jukkala was motivated to pursue her doctorate in Nursing with a focus on Rural Health Care. She received her PhD in 2005 from the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis.

Currently, Dr. Jukkala teaches courses in women's health and her program of research focuses on the area of rural hospital preparedness. Through her instruction at UAB and her research in rural, southern hospitals, Dr. Jukkala hopes to increase awareness of the needs and considerations for

providing competent care and responsible research in rural areas.

While the challenges of conducting rural healthcare research are great and often times difficult to overcome, Jukkala is undaunted, "I think anytime you are conducting rural healthcare research the challenge of low volume is there. In addition, the closing of many rural hospitals is a problem and many of the hospitals that do manage to stay open are discontinuing OB services".

Dr. Jukkala is enthusiastic about her work, "Gathering information from many rural hospitals allows me to form a "picture" of rural obstetrical services that many are unaware of - that is very rewarding for me".

As for the future directions of her research, Jukkala plans to continue examining the rural hospital environment, specifically in the area of quality of care.
