Permits or Certificates Required	Shippers' Responsibility	Receivers' Responsibility
<p>USDA permits are required for certain human or animal pathogens.</p> <p>Per regulations by the USDA or the CDC, Select Agents/ Toxins require a certificate of registration for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Possession,• Use, or• Transfer.	<p>When shipping internationally, the shipper is responsible for obtaining the import and/or export permit.</p>	<p>The receiver is responsible for obtaining all permits necessary for any countries through which the Category B package will travel.</p>
