Anti-Doping Research Grants Available

The PCC is an anti-doping research collaborative which supports the scientific advancement of anti-doping technology through grant funding.

Who may apply:

The PCC supports investigators **world-wide** whose scientific research has the potential for meaningful contribution to the detection or deterrence of performance enhancing drug use, and the protection of clean athletes. Previous grants have been awarded to both anti-doping scientists and those outside the field interested in contributing their acumen to solving pervasive anti-doping

challenges. Past recipients hail from academia, industry, and/or research laboratories.

[The PCC Fellowship Program](#) specifically seeks young PhDs looking to explore a career track in anti-doping through expert mentorship and real-world experience in a WADA-Accredited laboratory. The program offers \$150,000 over two years to support accepted candidates.

Eligible Projects:

Projects discovering less expensive or less invasive sample collection methods, improving current detection methods, and/or detecting designer substances are all excellent candidates for PCC funding. However, all high quality scientific projects which move the anti-doping movement forward will be considered. There are no formal funding limits; however, all budget items must be justified to result in a recommendation for funding. The average amount of a PCC award is \$202,000 USD.

How to apply:

Visit cleancompetition.org to get started. New users will need to create an account before beginning their pre-application.

What is a pre-application?

The PCC pre-application is designed to gather high level information on a project before an investigator submits the full, more time intensive application. The length of the pre-application is approximately two pages. Once a project is deemed eligible for PCC funding through the pre-application process,

investigators will be notified by email and will have until August 1st to submit full applications.

How long do funding decisions take?

Our typical turn around time for funding decisions is 4 months from submission of the pre-application. Historically, 33% of applications result in PCC funding.
