Tips to Prevent Cheating on Exams

These may not guarantee that students won't cheat, but they're a step in the right direction.

- 1. Scramble questions. If you're never done this, check out our previous Tip here.
- 2. Scramble answers. This option is found under the quiz details in Canvas.

 Note: If you do scramble the answers, you cannot use an "all of the above" or "none of the above" response. Instead, consider using a multiple response. (If you send your tests to the ISS team to input, this requires specific formatting. Check back next week for info on formatting tests.)
- 3. Use Respondus LockDown Browser AND a password. Be sure to follow these <u>new instructions</u> for LockDown Browser.
- 4. For online students, take advantage of <u>ProctorU</u> services. ProctorU provides free monitoring for 2 tests per semester. There is a fee for any additional tests (and a fee for **any** non-Q section courses).
