Canvas Apps

We wanted to address a question about Canvas Apps. If one clicks on the Settings tab in Canvas, they will see an apps heading appear. Once the tab is selected, a large number of apps appear, but little is known about most of these apps. Some of the apps are free. Some require paid subscriptions. Some are already approved by UAB. Some will still need approval if found to be useful by faculty. Today, we'd like to share with you the list of already approved and accessible apps which are encouraged for use.

Next week, we will provide you with a comprehensive list of all apps that are free, but may still require approval for course shell integration.
