

# **Publishing Grades and Setting up your Gradebook**

Would you like to pull your students' grades directly into Banner from Canvas? Follow these simple steps to get started!


Please note: In order for the Canvas to Banner feature to work, you must (1) enable the grading scheme in Canvas, (2) use the gradebook in Canvas, and (3) use the total column in the gradebook.

To use the Canvas to Banner grade publishing feature, please follow these steps.

# **Setting up your Gradebook**


- 1. Create a group under Assignments for each Category
- 2. Click Add Group



3. Add the Group Name and the % of total grade



#### 4. Click Save




NOTE: If you need to create a column for the Gradebook for something that is not an assignment (like a participation grade), you will still need to create a group and an assignment under the Assignments tab.


5. Click Add Assignment




6. Enter the Assignment details




7. Under Submission Type dropdown, choose No Submission



8. If you are ready to publish your assignment, click the Save & Publish button. If you want to create a draft of your assignment and publish it later, click the Save button. Note: Assignments do not appear in the Gradebook until they are published.



## 9. Your Assignments page should look something like the one below.



**NOTE:** Be sure to check your Syllabus for the percentages for each activity (see the example of percentages below)

- o Assignments 20%
- o Participation 10%
