

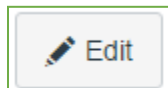

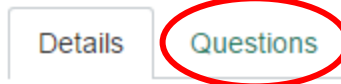
Do the Shuffle!

Do it! Shuffling quiz or exam questions can help deter wandering eyes. Here's how to shuffle questions once they're in Canvas:

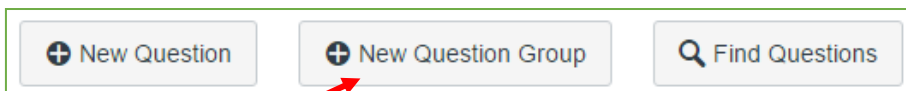
1. Click on the quiz, then



2. Go to the



3. Now scroll down to the bottom of the page until you find these:



4. Pick this one:

5. Edit the group details as needed, including the point value for each question and select:
