If you are a professional nurse with a full-time job, it can be very difficult to return to school. We encourage you to consider our distance accessible Neonatal Nurse Practitioner (NNP) program that allows you to remain in your home town for your clinical experiences, take distance accessible courses during the most convenient part of your day, and obtain a Master's degree in nursing. The purpose of the program is to prepare NNPs who are culturally competent and prepared to provide care for high risk infants and families through the first two years of the child's life.

Graduation from the program will qualify you to take the national NNP certification examination.
