- 1. Presentation type:** Oral vs. Poster; Posters will be put up on walls using tape (which we will provide). Oral presentations must use **PowerPoint in Windows format**. Bring the talk on a CD or USB memory stick.
Macintosh users: Please preview your presentation on a Windows PC. Some Mac-generated graphics cannot be imaged in Windows PowerPoint even if saved in “Windows format.” Try converting graphics that do not image on a PC into JPEGs and reinsert them. We may also have a Mac available for use so bring your talk in Mac format too, but be prepared to present it on the Windows machine if necessary.
