CAPP on-site services are delivered within a safe, confidential, and supportive setting. Services begin in pregnancy and extend beyond delivery. Each woman is offered services to meet her needs and the needs of her support system.

- Prenatal and postpartum care
- Medication assisted treatment
- Substance use assessment
- Intensive case management
- Outpatient substance use treatment
- Linkage to residential substance use treatment
- Peer recovery support
- In-home parenting education
- Court and child welfare advocacy
