CCTS Network Partner Auburn University is investing \$5 million in 11 groundbreaking research projects designed to deliver practical. life-changing solutions. Funded for three years by the Presidential Awards for Interdisciplinary Research (PAIR) initiative stood up by Auburn President Dr. Steven Leath, the projects include creating better biomedical implants for patients in need using 3D printing; building a mobile mitochondria lab (AU Mitomobile) to measure bioenergetics in natural settings; establishing sustainable research structure in east-central Alabama to assess psychosocial stressors that can contribute to lower life expectancy and faster progression of age-related diseases in rural African Americans; reducing and reusing carbon dioxide emissions for useful means; reducing the burden of neurological disease by increasing fundamental knowledge about the brain and nervous system; and developing therapies to improve outcomes for patients with nonalcoholic steatotic hepatitis (NASH). 
Small Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer Grants
