The goal of cross-hub multidisciplinary synergy papers is to advance the field of translational science and build collaborations within and external to the CTSA program consortium, while meeting the academic needs of coauthors to produce high-quality scientific publications. Development of synergy papers may also forge new relationships and teams around shared goals, create common vocabularies across translational stages, and serve as a springboard for future collaborations. Selected synergy papers will receive one year of administrative support to develop a manuscript and submit it to a scientific journal for publication. # Health Services, Outcomes and Effectiveness Research Training Program


