AWARD

Applicants may apply for up to \$60,000 in Direct Costs, with the CCTS Hub committing up to half.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE

From 2008-2018, CCTS invested \$1.73M in pilot funding. Our pilot PIs have secured more than \$83M (total cost) in additional external grant funding, a programmatic ROI of 49:1.

PROPOSALS
