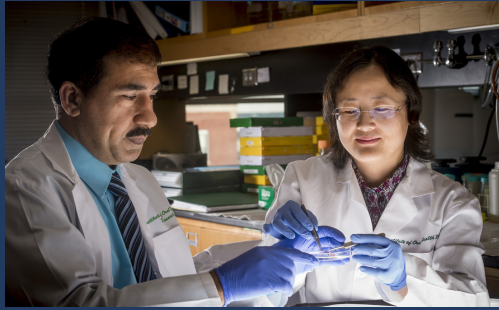


# Case Studies in Mentoring
