### Register for the Annual Translational and Transformative Informatics Symposium (ATTIS)

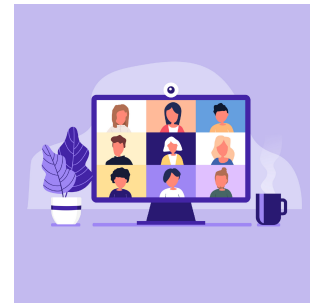
