SHARP – Students Helping At-Risk Patients



Students Helping At-Risk Patients This program which began in September brings together IP care teams of 12 students from Medicine, Nursing and Social Work to support small groups of chronically ill patients “at-risk” for poor outcomes. In the pilot each team, along with preceptors from all 3 schools will each follow 3-5 patients who are receiving care for chronic illnesses in a UAB clinic. Teams have already completed Orientation, Patient Assessment and Patient Check-in meetings and will follow and support their patients until the end of the Spring Semester.

Faculty Interprofessional Leadership Scholars



This is a one-year program in which Faculty IP Leadership scholars will attend the IPEC IP Faculty 101 workshops. Scholars then work together to create a new IP course or activity for UAB. They will also participate in the OIPC/CTL workshop series and a local IP education meeting.
