

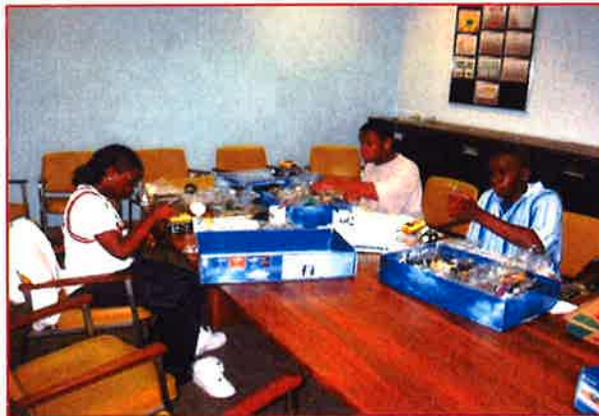
CORD CompU Camp



The University of Alabama at Birmingham's Center for Community OutReach Development (CORD) in partnership with the Gear Up Birmingham will recruit 6th and 7th grade students in Birmingham City Schools to participate in a series of summer computer camps that will focus on developing knowledge of software related to the programming of robots.

Each camp will last 1 week (9-5) M-F and 4 camps will be scheduled. Dr. Wyss in concert with Computer Science Graduate Keiah L. Shauku and other facilitators from UAB's Computer Information Sciences and Engineering Departments will conduct the program. CompU Camp is a program to advance technology education for students. The students will first learn general concepts in computer programming and the basic operations that are required for use in computing. Then, already in the first day of camp, they will be introduced to Lego Robots and start learning how to use the programming to program the robots. This provides students with an initial understanding of JAVA, one of the main languages of computer programming. Students will end each week by competing in a Robot Roundup. Further, students can compete in the statewide Lego Robot competition in the winter.

The camps will occur during the 4 weeks of July 2015. 2 weeks will be at the Central Birmingham Library and 2 weeks will be at the Vestavia Hills Library.
