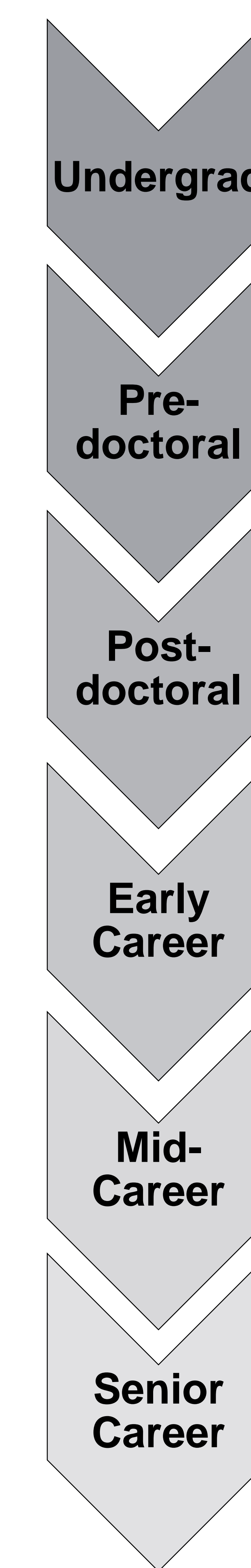


## CCTS

	<b>Grant Writing Intensive Cohorts (GRIT) ◆</b> GRIT offers invaluable support and access to expertise for early stage investigators, trainees, & postdocs who are applying for grants and awards						
	<b>LEAD (Learn Enhance Advance Drive) ◆</b> Program focused on developing the fundamental competencies within junior faculty & staff who are in leadership roles or will be in leadership roles soon

### Formal Programs



#### TL1 Program

- Year-out program
- Mentored-research experience
- Focused on pre-doctoral health professions (e.g. MD, PharmD, DMD, etc.) across CCTS partner institutions.
- 15 trainees per program annually
- Over 40 mentors to oversee mentored-research experience
- Co-mentor identified at home institution to continue research training following TL1 program
- Weekly didactic programs
- Year-out program completes MSPH (med students), or certificate/CTS-TP

#### KL2 Program

- Provides two years of support for early career faculty
- Transitional research focusing on any discipline or disease
- Team-based mentored research experience including mentors from partner network outside of home institution
- Primary pool of 87 "senior mentors" from across partner network representing 58 Divisions/Departments/Schools
- Pool of 30 "associate mentors" from across Partner Network representing current or recent institutional supported K awardees
