The T-90/R-90 Training Program funded by the NIDCR prepares its fellows for an academic career in either Basic Science or Clinical Translational Research.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. citizenship or permanent residency.
- Predoctoral position Second-year graduate student who is in good academic standing and has been accepted into a laboratory to conduct full-time research.
- Research focus related to basic or clinical research in any of the following areas:
  - Craniofacial Development / Genetics
  - Oral Microbiology, Infection / Host Response
  - Biomaterial Science / Biomimetic
  - Implementation Science / Clinical Outcomes
  - Oral Cancer & Bone Marrow Microenvironment

- A recommendation letter from the research mentor
