For unconditional admission to the Alternative Class A Certification in Music-Choral (P-12), candidates must:

- 1) have a passing score on the Praxis subject assessment in Music;
- 2) have an unrounded cumulative 2.50 GPA on a bachelor's degree transcript (or 3.0 on master's degree transcript) from a regionally accredited institution and a suitable background clearance;
- 3) meet all other criteria as required by the UAB Graduate School
- 4) meet all other criteria for the alternative master's degree program required for the Department of Music.
