Requirements for Applying to TEP

- **Apply for TEP in the Fall (October) before entering TEP.**

Requirements
Completion of the following Professional Studies courses with a minimum GPA of 2.75 or higher. Any course with a grade below “C” must be retaken. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• EDU 200 Education as a Profession• CHHS 200 Quality of Life• EDF 362 Foundations of Education I: Social, Historical, & Philosophical• EPR 363 Foundations of Education II: Psychological• ECY 300 Survey of Special Education• EDR 421 Reading in the Content Area
Completion of 41 semester hours in the Core Curriculum and seven semester hours in pre-professional/major courses.
Minimum GPA of 2.75 in Core Curriculum Requirements (Areas I-IV) in accordance with UAB Course Repeat Policy
Minimum higher education GPA of 2.75 in accordance with UAB Course Repeat Policy
Background check status shown as “cleared” on ALSDE Certification Portal a) Register at https://www.aps.gemalto.com/al/index_adeNew.htm . Under Registration (right column), click “Register Online.” b) Pay online with debit or credit card, print receipt, have fingerprints done within 30 days, and access results in about one week. c) Access ALSDE’s background clearance (earlier and newly issued) at https://tcert.alsde.edu/Portal/Public/Pages/SearchCerts.aspx
Grade of at least one “B” and one “C” in EH 101 and EH 102
Grade of “C” or higher in CM 101
Grade of “C” or better in all math, science, and major courses
Passing score on spontaneous speaking sample in TEP interview
Score of “pass” on TEP interview as reviewed by faculty
Evidence of the dispositions needed to be a successful teacher
