Program Admission Requirements for Class AA Certification in Elementary Education
In addition to meeting the requirements for admission to the Graduate School, a candidate must meet requirements for unconditional admission to the Elementary Education Program. To be eligible for unconditional admission to this program, a candidate must hold a valid Alabama master's level professional educator certificate in Elementary Education (Class A) OR meet one of the special circumstances noted on the second page of this document.

ALSDE Requirements for Class AA Certification in Elementary Education
Once a candidate has completed checklist requirements and has met all admission, exit, and certification requirements, the candidate will be eligible for Class AA certification in Elementary Education. To be eligible for this certification, the candidate must:

- Submit a completed application for certification during the last term of enrollment in the Class AA Elementary Education Program*;
- Complete the Class AA program with a minimum GPA of 3.5 on all course checklists; and
- Possess a Class A Professional Certificate as outlined on the second page of this document.

Prospective students should NOT begin any coursework without first seeking advisement from the Department of Curriculum and Instruction. Students who ignore this admonition assume responsibility for their own mistakes.

*An individual who completes this program must submit application for Alabama certification within 60 calendar months of completion of this program.

Unconditional Admission to a Class AA Program for Teaching Fields. Requirements for unconditional admission shall include a **valid** master's level professional educator certificate in the same teaching field(s) in which the Class AA Professional Educator Certificate is sought, except as prescribed below:

(a) Special circumstances:

1. A teacher with a **valid** bachelor's level professional educator certificate in early childhood education and a **valid** master's level professional educator certificate in Reading may be unconditionally admitted to a Class AA program in Early Childhood Education.
2. A teacher with a **valid** bachelor's level professional educator certificate in any teaching field and a **valid** master's level professional educator certificate in English for Speakers of Other Languages may be unconditionally admitted to a Class AA program in the same teaching field for which the teacher holds a **valid** bachelor's level professional educator certificate.

- (b) If an individual is unconditionally admitted to an Alabama Class AA program based on a **valid** master's level professional educator certificate in another state, completes a Class AA program, and subsequently applies for Alabama certification at the Class AA level, then the individual must hold at least a **valid** Class A Professional Educator Certificate before applying for Class AA certification.
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
