

**Food Truck Guidelines:**

- Food trucks need to be an approved vendor, UAB Vendor Compliance should be contacted to ensure all requirements are met. Once completed and approved the food truck operator should reach out to Campus Safety to begin the safety review process
- Campus safety must be notified two weeks in advance of event
- Safety inspection must be completed by Campus Safety and have an annual inspection in date to operate
- Must have copy of Health Department permit
- Notice of Physical location/Permission from owner
- Set-up must be at-least 10 feet from the building/facility
- Cannot block sidewalks, ADA ramps and access, fire lanes, streets, or traffic flow
- Separation between food trucks must be at-least 10 feet apart
- Verification of insurance to include general liability/automobile coverage
- All fire extinguishers should have annual inspection in date
- All hood suppression systems should have current inspection in date
- If using propane cylinders, they must be certified. Meaning they should be marked with the month and year the cylinder was manufactured, or recertified
- If using propane, LPG leak detector must be installed in the interior of the vehicle
