

SAFETY TRAINING FOR LAB WORKERS

Laboratory Workers at UAB are required to take training to fulfill regulatory requirements and to prove understanding of proper practices in the laboratory. A record of training for each lab member is required to be kept on file with the laboratory in which they are working. Record of training is available at [BlazerNET](#). Click on the Courses and Training Tab. Locate the Training and Requirements Dashboard on the right side. Click the BEDROC status page link. Work in a laboratory that uses BSL1 or BSL2 containment, practices or procedures,	BIO 303 - Basic Biosafety	Once
Are a UAB employee who chooses to ship a package using dry ice,	BIO200 - Shipping with Dry Ice	Every two years, or if regulations change
Are a UAB employee who handles or offers for transport a Category B, Infectious Substance,	BIO201 - Shipping Category B, Infectious Substances	Every two years, or if regulations change
Are a UAB employee who handles, or offers for transport, a Category A Infectious Substance,	BIO202 - Shipping Category A, Infectious Substances	Every two years, or if regulations change
Come in contact with human blood, body fluids and other potentially infectious material in the work environment,	BIO300 - Bloodborne Pathogens	Once, with an annual refresher of the material
Generate, handle, pack or sign for the pickup of medical waste in research laboratories at UAB,	BIO301L – Medical Waste Management for Labs	Every three years, or if regulations change
Generate, handle, pack or sign for the pickup of chemical waste in research laboratories at UAB,	CS055 - Chemical Waste Handling and Packing	Annually
Work in a lab that uses chemicals,	CS101 - Chemical Safety	Once, annual refresher recommended
*Do not work with non-human primates or have allergies, ** Work with non-human primates or have allergies,	UAB Employee Health	Initially <i>AND</i> every 2 years* <i>OR</i> every year** <i>OR</i> if your job tasks change
Work with radioisotopes,	RS1000 - Radiation Safety Training – <i>or equivalent</i>	Once
Have had 5 years pass since your last radiation safety training class and currently work with radioisotopes,	RSR2001 – Radiation Safety Refresher Course – <i>or equivalent</i>	Once every five years
