



Interactive Presentation Student Worksheet

In this activity, you will create an Interactive Presentation. Your project will be on a chosen theme, and each Sprite (or programmable object) will represent something related to your topic. The project will be interactive, that means when you click on a Sprite, it will say a fact or property of your topic.

For example, if you were making a project about the three types of rocks, there would be an interactive Sprite representing each type of rock. And when each Sprite was clicked on, it would give some information about that type of rock.

1) What will be the theme of your project?		

2) In the table below, list each Sprite that you will need in your project and then write the information that the Sprite will say when clicked.
