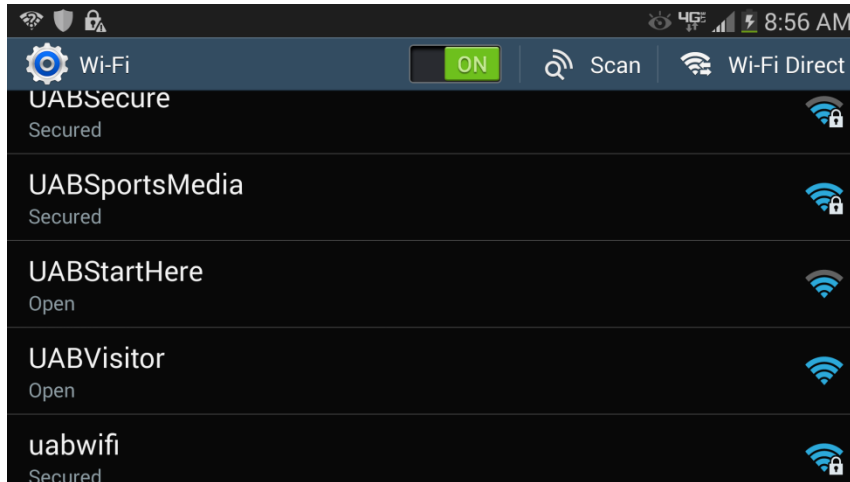
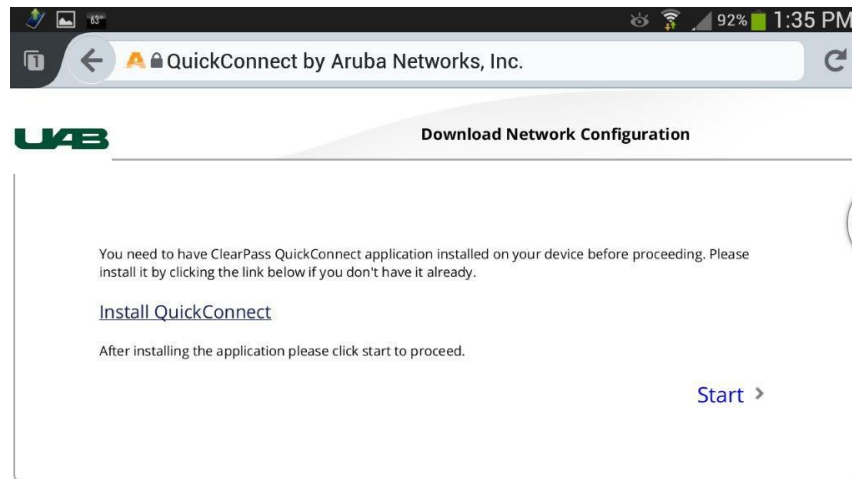


1. Connect to the “UABStartHere” wireless network. If you are already connected to a network you can navigate to <https://dcns-cp1.ad.uab.edu/guest/public/arubaquickconnect/> to install the UABSecure profile.

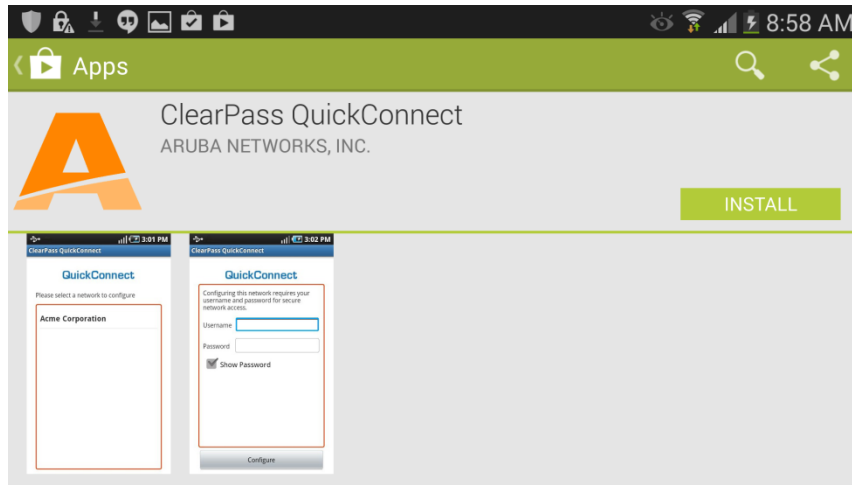


2. Once connected to “UABStartHere” open a browser and attempt to navigate to any URL. You will be directed to the Quickconnect portal. Before clicking “Start” you must first install the QuickConnect app on your phone. Tap “Install QuickConnect” to go to the Google Play store.

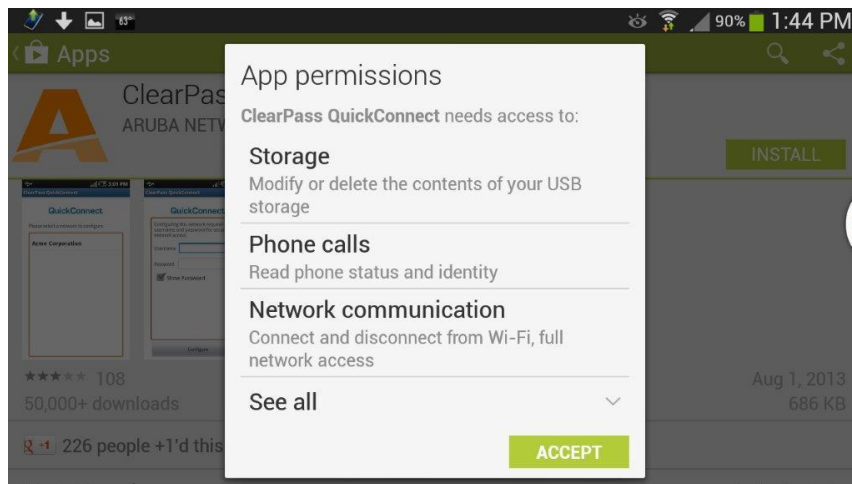


**Note:** You will need a Google account to access the Google Play store. Your phone will take you through the process of creating account if you don't have one, or you can use your existing Google account (including GMail and Youtube accounts). It will ask if you want to add your credit card information for purchasing applications. This is not necessary, as the QuickConnect application is free.

3. Tap "Install"



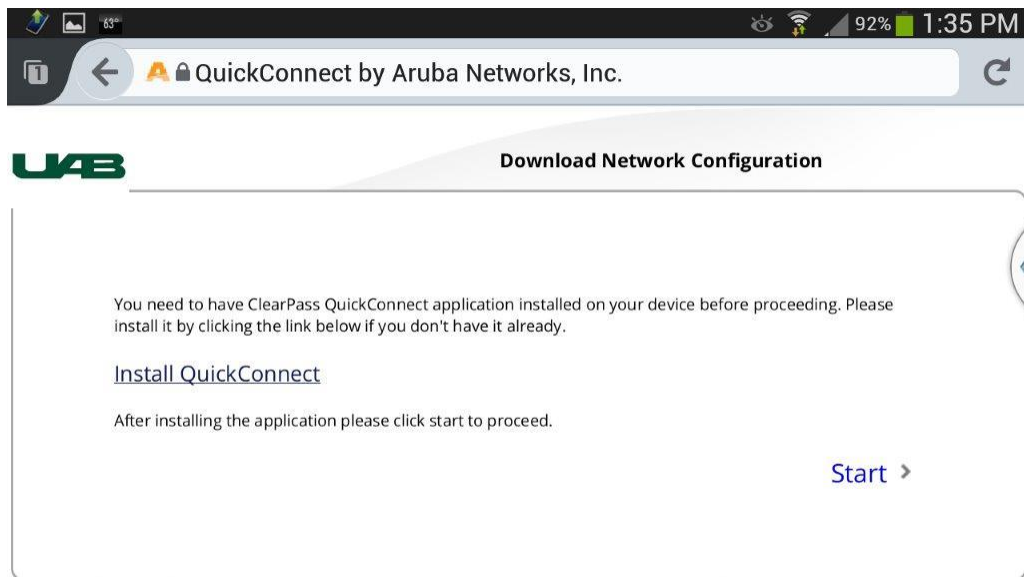
4. Click "Accept" to approve the permissions for this application. This will begin the installation.



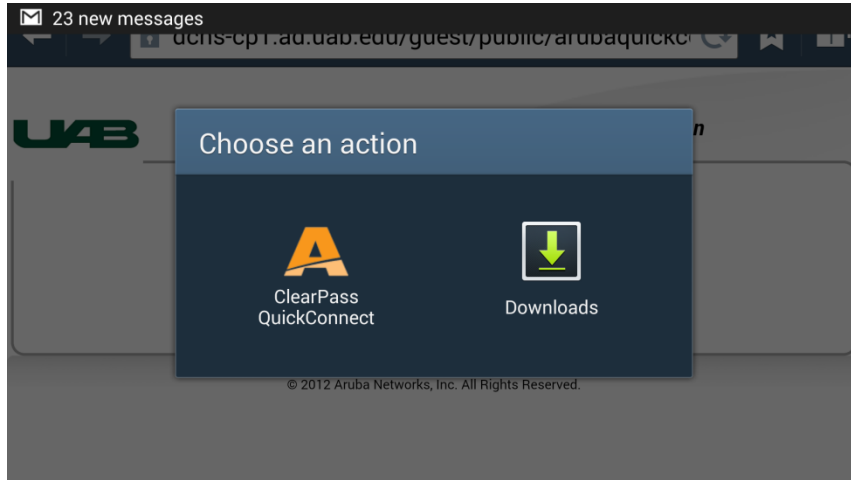
5. Once the download and installation is completed you should see the Aruba ClearPass icon.



6. Once QuickConnect installed go back to the browser and tap "Start".



7. At the "Choose an action" prompt tap "ClearPass QuickConnect".



8. Enter your Blazer ID and password in the appropriate box.

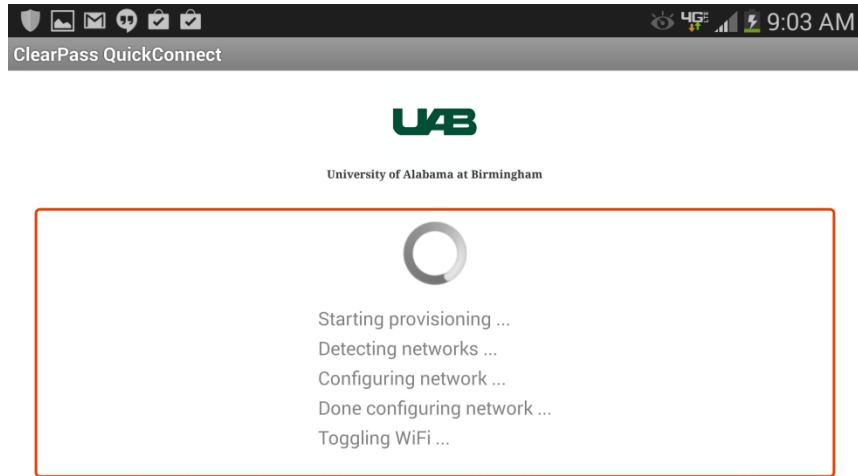
