

CFAR Pilot Funding RFA 2018-2019

Budget: Up to \$50,000
Time: 1 Year

CFAR is pleased to release this RFA for new pilots incorporating the pillars of the CFAR mission of **HIV Basic Sciences to Impact Clinical Outcomes, Behavioral Epidemiology and Intervention, Population Health Prevention and Treatment, and Community Engaged Research.**

Eligibility: Faculty and Fellows are eligible. Investigators developing a new and novel idea in HIV are invited to apply. Preference will be given to those who have never had an R01 in an HIV/AIDS field of study or who are new to HIV research. Established investigators with an R01 in HIV/AIDS are eligible to apply if they are exploring a new direction. The integration of early stage faculty with other UAB researchers and community partners/stakeholders is key and required to advance all pilot projects within the context of a team building approach.
