SITUATION/QUESTION:

There is a person I emailed once years ago (and will probably never email again), whose name/address includes **JaneRare**

But there is a different person that I email a lot, whose name/address includes **JaneFrequent**

But when I type **Jane**, the autofill thinks I might mean **JaneRare** but I definitely don't, and this has been a low-key frustration for years now.

How can I tell autofill that that is Not a helpful suggestion and so to please quit suggesting it?

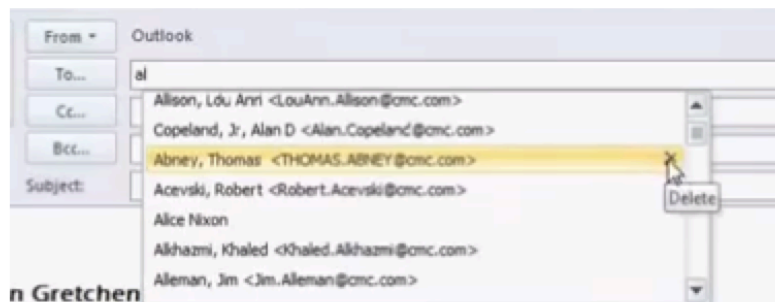
SOLUTION/ANSWER:

Autofill is a feature that automatically populates form fields with previously-entered information, such as addresses.

It's very easy to remove one these suggestions.

When that suggestion comes up as you type the address, just:

- arrow down to it and press the delete key, or
- float your mouse over it and click on the "X" as shown here
